Mouth care Guideline:

INTUBATED PATIENT

- Assess oral cavity to provide frequency of interventions healthy oral cavity prn, moderate dysfunction 4 hourly, severe dysfunction 2 hourly.
- Maintain ETT cuff pressure 20-30cmH20 whilst undertaking mouth care, suction the oral cavity before and inflating OR deflating the ETT cuff.
- Aspirate secretions from oral cavity before mouthcare as care will stimulate production of oral secretions
- Check position of ETT at the start and end of care

DENTATE PATIENT:

• IF ABLE TO TOLERATE TOOTHBRUSHING - BD toothbrushing for 2 minutes with fluoride toothpaste preferably a non foaming

Toothbrushing 12 hours apart - 05:00 and 17:00

- Keep lips moistened with lip balm / petroleum jelly PRN (ensure excess removed from ETT)
 - Keep mouth moistened using pink swabs and sterile water (frequency as above)

EDENTATE PATIENT (TOOTHLESS):

- Keep lips moistened with lip balm / petroleum jelly PRN (ensure excess removed from ETT)
 - Keep mouth moistened using pink swabs and sterile water (frequency as above)

EXTUBATED PATIENT:

- BD toothbrushing for 2 minutes with fluoride toothpaste (if dentate and able to tolerate toothbrushing)
- For patients with dentures: clean dentures with denture cream BD, clean gums instead of toothbrushing
 - keep mouth moistened using pink swabs and water (frequency suggested above)
 - · keep lips moistened with lip balm / petroleum jelly PRN
